Bids may be held by the OWNER for a period of **ninety (90)** days from the date of the opening of the Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding the Contract.

If the contract is to be awarded, it will be awarded to the lowest Bidder whose evaluation by Owner indicates to Owner that the award will be in the best interests of the Project. The Owner reserves the right to determine the best interests of the Project based on Owner's first-hand experience with or knowledge about Bidders, including information regarding safety records of Bidders provided in the Greater Texoma Utility Authority's Contractor Qualification Statement, and may award the contract based on a preference because of such experience or knowledge.

This contract is contingent upon release of funds from the Texas Water Development Board.

Any contract or contracts awarded under this Advertisement for Bids are expected to be funded in part by a loan from the Texas Water Development Board. Neither the State of Texas nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Advertisement for Bids or any resulting contract.
