

## REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Sealed proposals addressed to the Greater Texoma Utility Authority will be received at the offices of the General Manager, Greater Texoma Utility Authority, 5100 Airport Drive, Denison, Texas 75020, until 2:00 P.M. on July 9, 2009 for furnishing all necessary material, equipment and labor required for the construction of the following projects:

### City of Howe Pump Station

Bids will be opened at authority's offices, beginning at 2:00 P.M. on July 9, 2009. The project includes, but is not necessarily limited to the following work:

Installation of a packaged pump station (375 gallons per minute capacity), chlorination facilities, ammoniation facilities, meter, slab, yard piping with all necessary mechanical, electrical, appurtenances and telemetry.

Bidders must submit with their bids a Cashier's Check or a Certified Check in the amount of five (5%) percent of the maximum amount of bid payable without recourse to the Owner or a proposal bond in the same amount. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish not only a performance bond in the amount of the contract, but also a payment bond for the protection of all claimants supplying labor and materials.

The Owner reserves the right to determine the best interests of the Project based upon the Owner's firsthand experience with or knowledge about Bidders, including information regarding safety records provided in the Greater Texoma Utility Authority's Qualification Statement to be submitted by Bidders.

This contract will be funded through the Texas Water Development Board, and the following provisions will apply:

1. The contract will be contingent upon release of funds from the Water Development Board.
2. Any contract or contracts awarded under this Invitation for Bids are expected to be funded in part by a loan from the Texas Water Development Board. Neither the State of Texas nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees are or will be a party to this Invitation for Bids or any resulting contract.

Equal Opportunity in Employment - All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, handicap or national origin. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246, as amended by Executive Order 11375, and as supplemented in Department of labor regulations 41 CFR Part 60.
